<u>1793</u>

Returns to London to ask the Admiralty for a ship. Appointed a flag captain to rear Admiral George Bowyer. It is a 92 gun ship 'Prince'. A second daughter 'Mary Patience, is born.

<u>1794</u>

Britain at war with France. Transfers to the 98 gun ship 'Barfleur'. Takes part in the battle called 'The Glorious First of June'. The French are defeated.

<u>1795</u>

Takes command of the 74 gunship 'Excellent'. Sails into the Mediterranean to attack French shipping.

<u>1797</u>

Britain at war with Spain and France. Takes part in the battle of Cape St Vicnent. The Spanish navy is defeated. Receives a gold medal.

<u>1799</u>

Returns to Morpeth. Promoted Rear Admiral of the White. Admiral was the most important officer. A rear admiral of the white was the lowest post of Admiral.

<u>1799</u>

Back at sea. He blockades the French ships so that they cannot leave their port without fighting the British navy.
