

1800

Transfers to the 98 gun ship 'Barfleur'.

1801

Promoted Rear Admiral of the Red. Next in line to becoming a full admiral. His wife and eldest daughter travel all the way from Northumberland to Plymouth to visit him.

1801

Buys the house he had rented in Morpeth, Northumberland.

1802

Short peace with France. Collingwood returns to his home at Morpeth.

1803

War breaks out with France and Spain again. Collingwood returns to blockade the French ships in their ports.

1804

Collingwood promoted to Admiral of the Blue.

1805

Blockades the Spanish port of Cadiz. The French and Spanish ships come out to defeat and are soundly beaten at the Battle of Trafalgar. Nelson, Collingwood's friend' is killed in the battle.
