

1806

Collingwood is given the title of 'Baron'.  
He is put in charge of the actions in the  
Mediterranean.

1809

Collingwood's dog 'Bounce' is accidentally  
washed overboard and lost. Collingwood  
transfers to his last ship 'Ville de Paris'.

1810

Collingwood becomes very ill. He hands  
over command of the navy and begins  
the voyage home. On 7 March he dies.  
On 11 May he is buried at St Paul's Ca-  
thedral.
